Regarding the problem faced in this current condition I have made up my mind to create a website of this dog training center using only HTML and JavaScript and this website has following features:

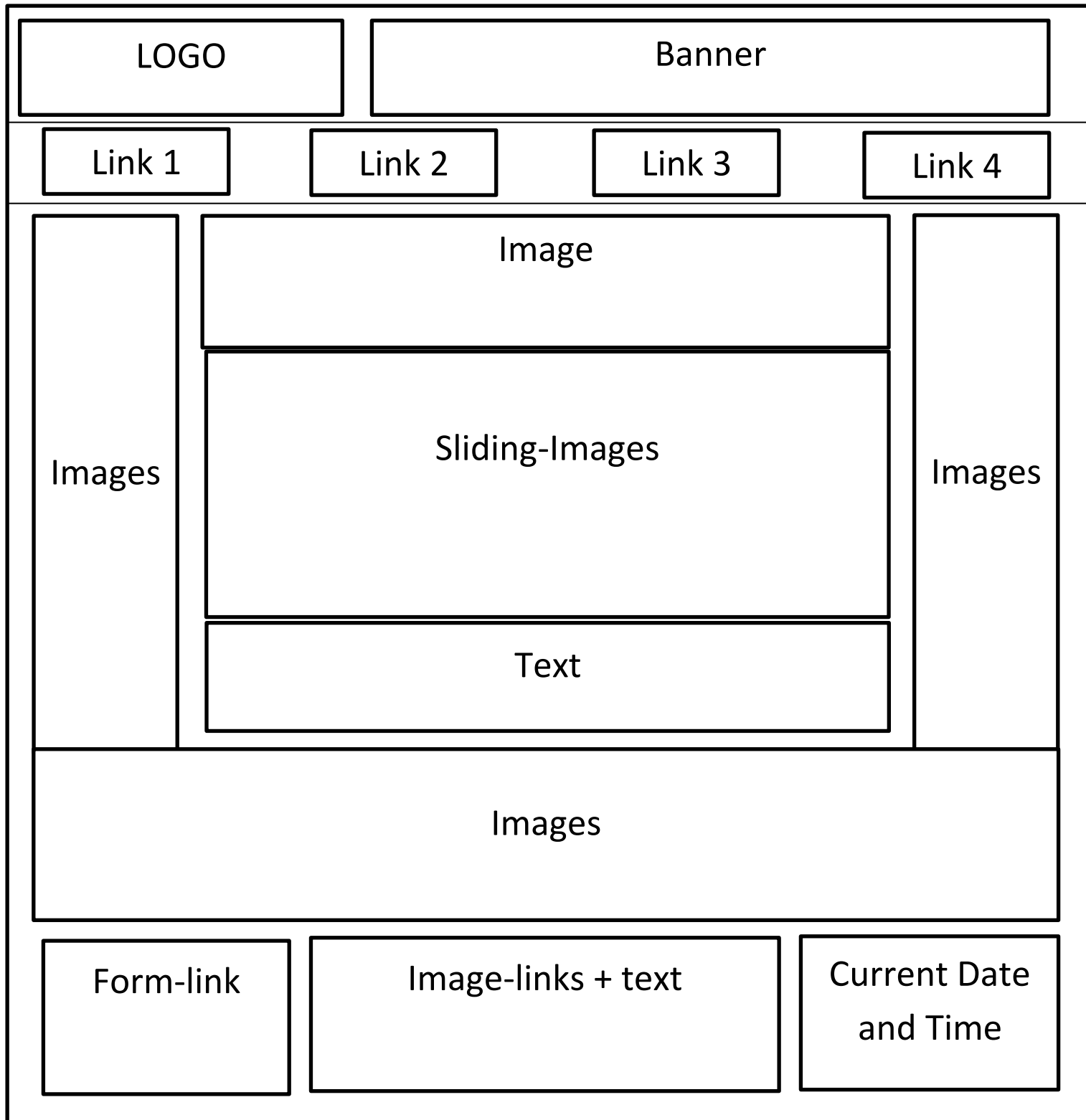
- By developing this website people of all around the world have knowledge of our existence and our services.

5. Aim of making website:

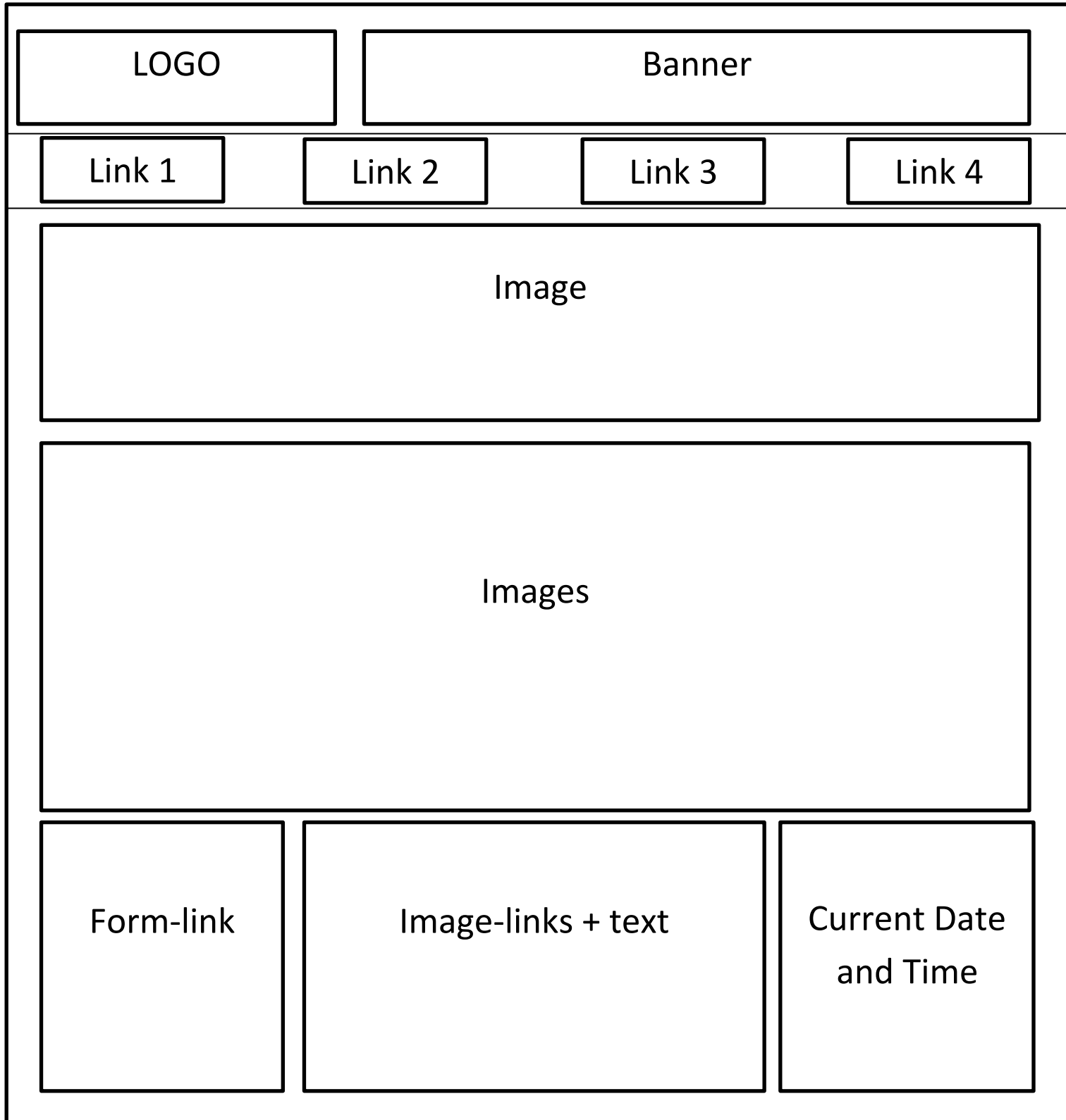

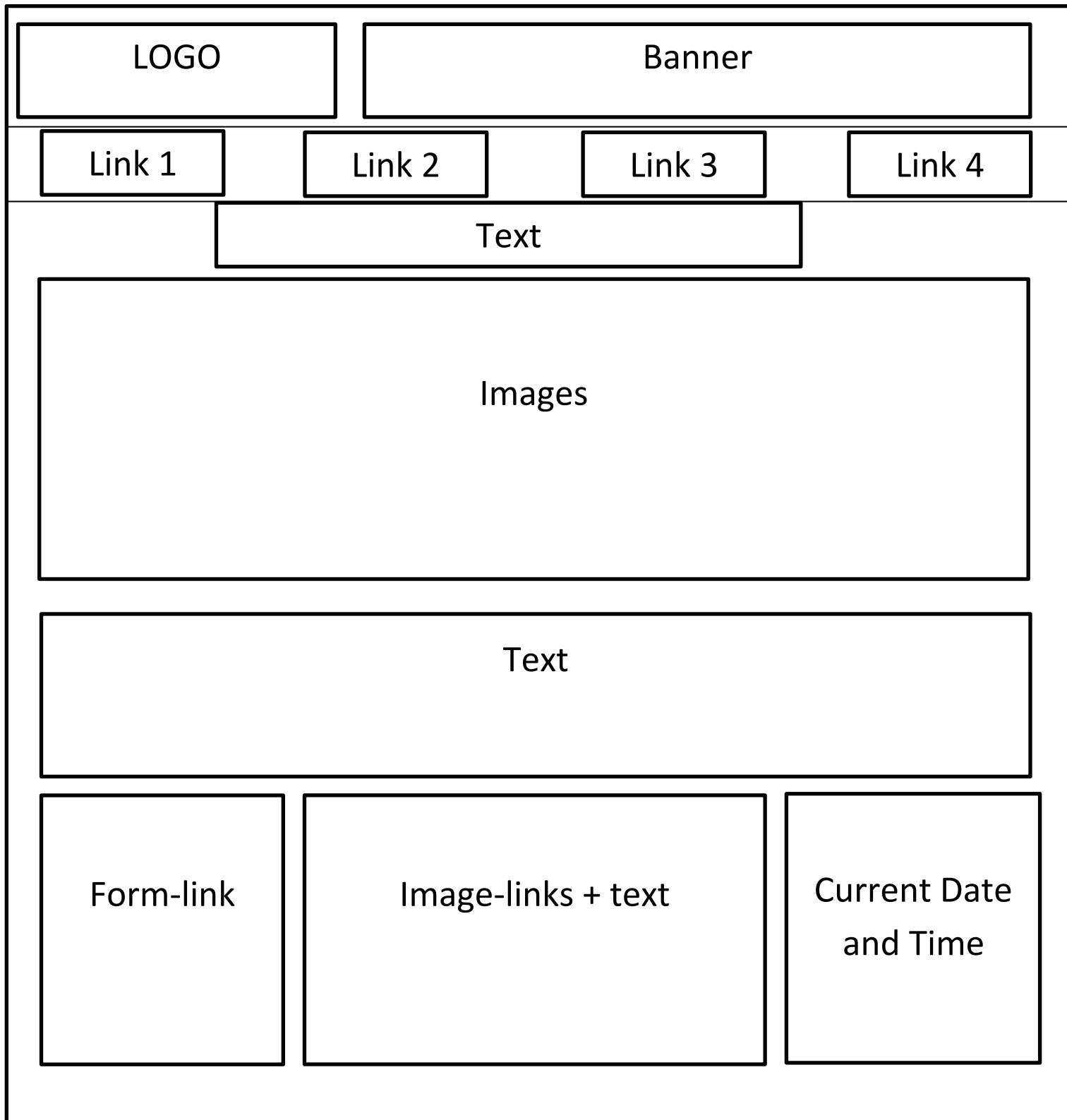

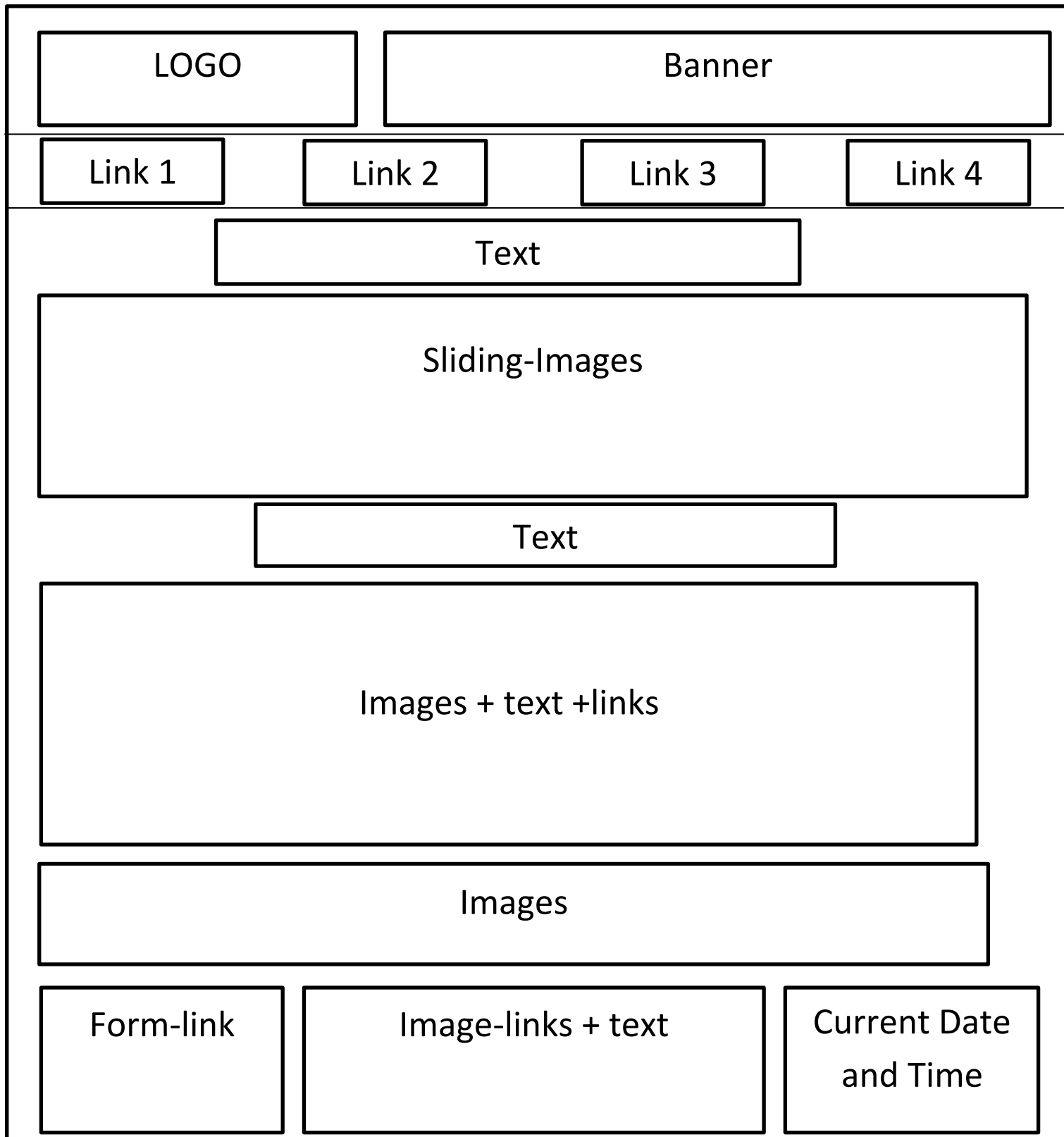

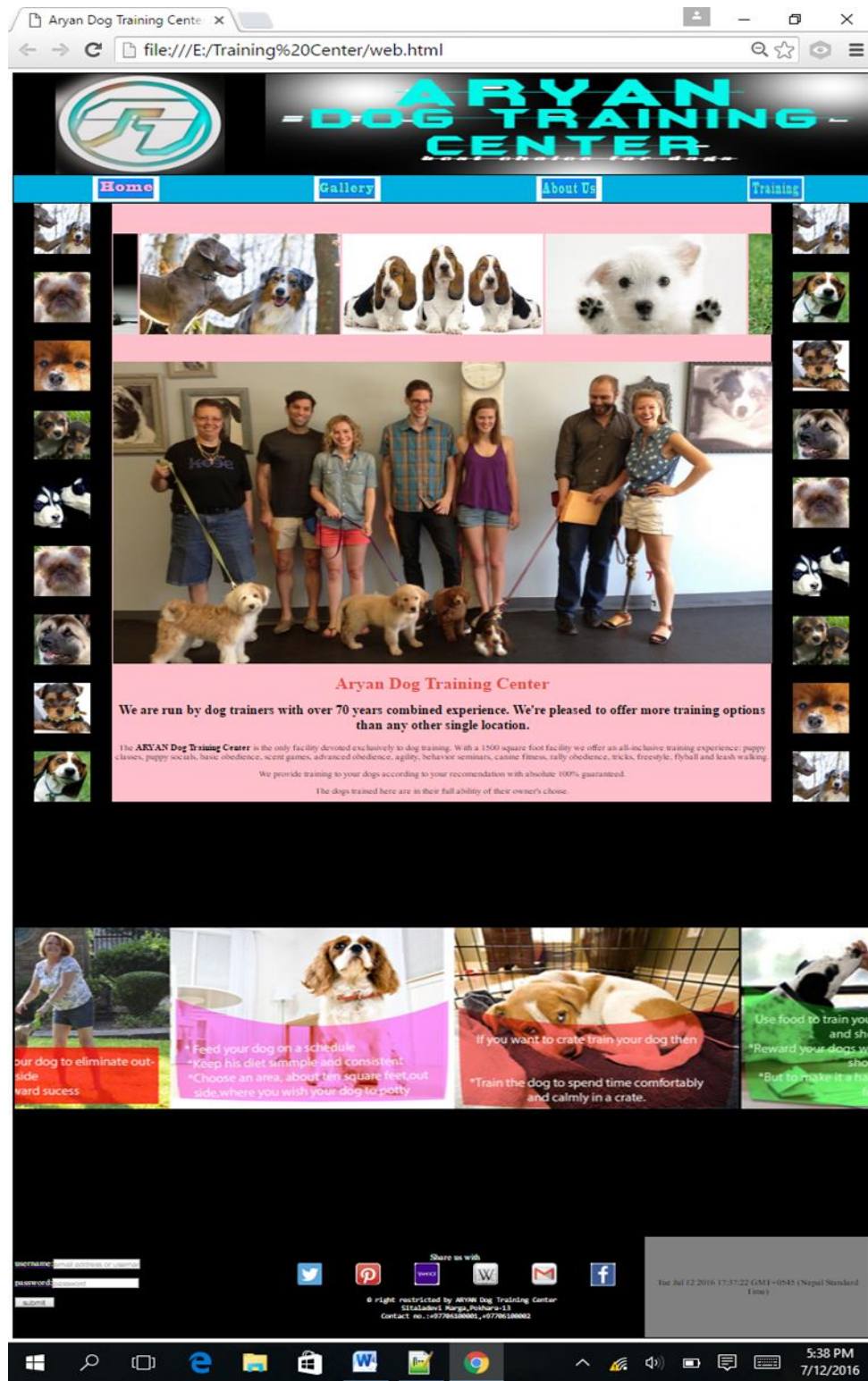


Fig: HOME PAGE



Fig: GALLERY PAGE

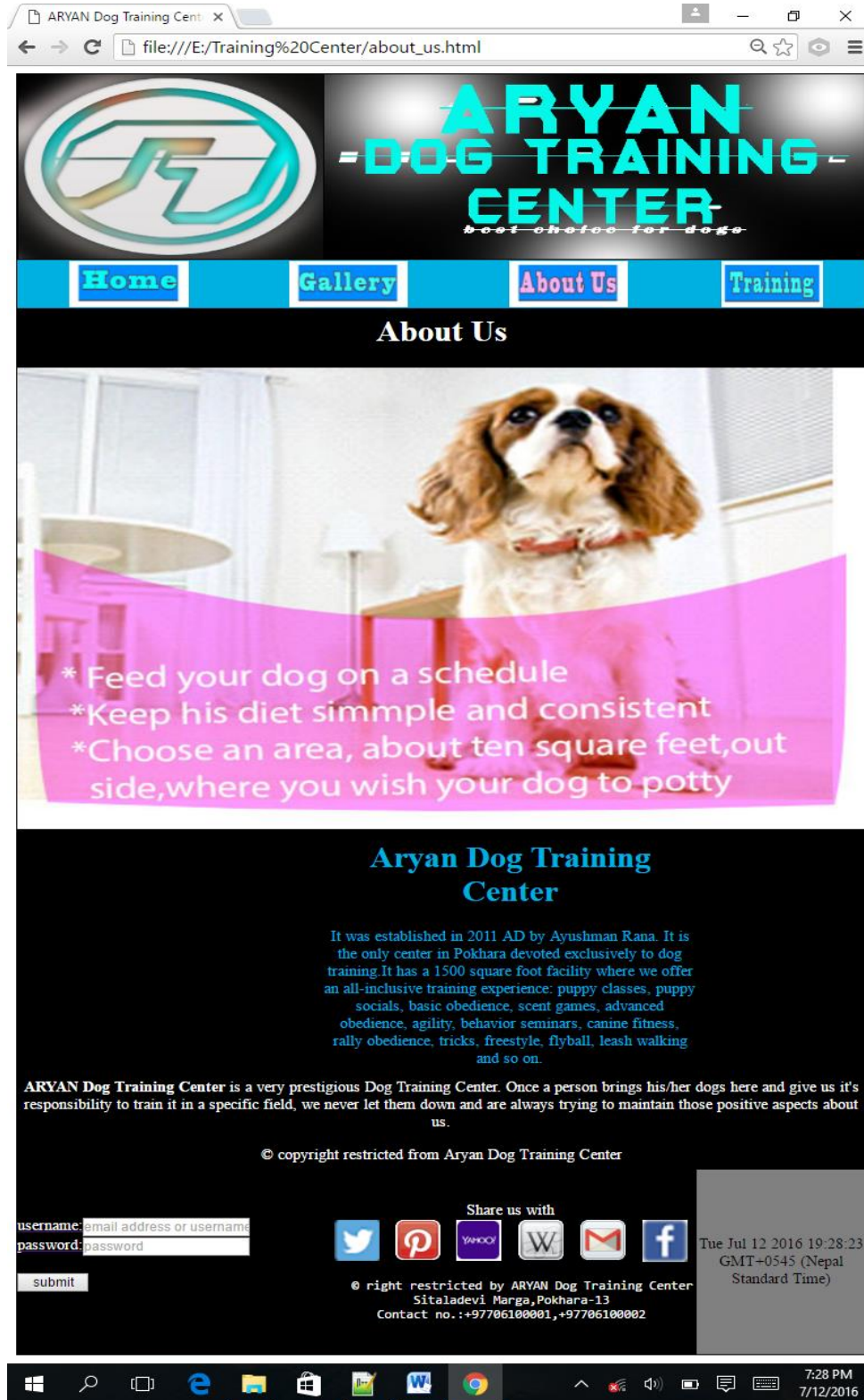


Fig: ABOUT US PAGE

<p>Just because the bag says "a treat all dogs love" doesn't mean your dog will
automatically love it. Some dogs are very selective about what they like to eat. Soft and
chewy treats are usually more exciting for your dog than hard and crunchy treats.

Keep your eyes open for what he enjoys.</p>

<h2>Tell Them What You Want Them To Do</h2>

<p>There is nothing inherently wrong with telling your dog "no", except that it doesn't give him enough information. Instead of telling your dog "no", tell him what you want him to do. Dogs don't generalize well,

so if your dog jumps up on someone to say hello and you say "no", he may jump higher or he may jump to the left side instead of the right. A better alternative would be to ask him to "sit". Tell him what you want him to do in order to avoid confusion.</p>

BRIBERY VS. REWARD

<p>The idea of using treats to train is often equated with bribery. Truthfully, dogs do what works. If using treats gets them to do what you want, then why not? You can also use the world around you as a reinforcement.

Every interaction you have with your dog is a learning opportunity, so when you think about it, you probably don't use food very often except during active training sessions. So why does your dog continue to hang out?

Because you reinforce him with praise, touch, games and walks.

Just remember, the behavior should produce the treat; the treat should not produce the behavior.

Any great dog trainer can tell you: Dogs and owners who play together, stay together.

There is nothing better for teaching your dog impulse control, confidence and bonding you to him than a game you both enjoy.</p>

<p>Not all dogs are into "object play" or interacting with a toy, so you might have to get creative with your game.

Think for a minute about your dog.

What would he choose to do today over any other activity? Perhaps he would choose to play tug of war with the dog down the street, chase squirrels, dig up the yard or, jump in the neighbor's pool?</p>

<p>Your dog's age, breed and temperament may give us hints toward his favorite games. A retriever may love to fetch on land or water, a terrier may love to play tug of war,

and a herding dog may love to play a prey game, using his favorite toy tied to a string and a stick (think giant cat toy).</p>

<p>When you create a game for your dog it is best to put some structure to it.

You don't want the game to become another problem behavior, so set some rules. The way we play with our dog matters.

If you choose to play fetch or tug spend some time working on dropping or releasing the object (try starting with two of the same toys

and trading him one for the other to the command "drop it"). If you are going to play searching games take some time to build a fun course.

Think about an area of your home where you could set up seven to 10 empty small boxes; hide treats in five or more of the boxes and encourage him to "find it". Play often causes dogs to get excited.

This will help you work through frustration and impulse control behaviors like barking or jumping up.

If you reward incompatible behaviors you will have a dog offering wonderful behaviors for the thing he loves most.</p>

<p>If you want to make your dog want to be with you, food isn't the only way to reward
or motivate your dog. Pick something that motivates your dog;

a toy, a tug, a tennis ball, a flirt pole. Don't expect them to play with it on their own,
playing is a two way street.</p>

<p>One way to make your dog want something is for them to see you playing with it,
anything, even a water bottle can be a fun toy if you give it value by playing with it.
Tease them or play with it on your own or with whoever else is there.

If you are going to recommend crate training for your dogs when they are adopted, crate train them while they are at the shelter.

This approach is easier on the dog: the dog is not completely bonded to one person at the shelter and so experiences less separation distress when crated.

Crate training at the shelter also helps the adopter who may be reluctant to use a crate or be unfamiliar with crate training. When the shelter has already crate trained the dog,

the adopters will be more likely to use the crate, and the chances for a permanent, successful adoption are greatly increased.</p>

<p>Which dogs should you target for crate training while at the shelter?

Adolescent dogs, less than two years old.

Dogs which are active, playful and rambunctious (play with furniture, pillows, books, magazines, eyeglasses, etc).

Prey-driven, mouthy dogs (who could gut a couch in two minutes).

Un-housebroken, unclean dogs.

When counseling owners to crate train their already bonded dog, the process can be slow and tedious because the dog is usually very upset about being separated from his owner.

At the shelter, the dog has no strong attachments; therefore, this is the prime time to crate train. REMEMBER – you cannot counsel or do this type of quick, easy crate training with dogs already in a home.

This is NOT the advice to give to owners over the phone.

Instead, this is advisable only for dogs in shelters.

</p>

<p>What do you need?

Crate

Soft blanket

Toy Chewies

Water

Goal: Train the dog to spend time comfortably and calmly in a crate

Note:<i>Never crate-train your dog with a choke-type collar on or with a leash attached to his collar.</i>

Place soft blankets and toys in the crate.

Clip a small bucket of water in the crate.

Find natural, short opportunities to crate train: a one hour nap, a ten minute "chew on the bone stretch," a rest after a tiring exercise session,

or an overnight all make good crate training opportunities.

Crate train only for the amount of time the dog can comfortably hold his bladder and bowels.

The rule of thumb for puppies is to crate in hours for the age of the puppy in months plus one. For example, a four-month-old puppy can stay in a crate comfortably for at most five hours.

No dog should ever be crated for more than nine hours at a stretch.

Always supervise dogs when they are first crate trained to ensure they are not panicking.

Never force a dog into a crate or lock a panicking dog in a crate.

Some dogs will not take readily to a crate and may panic or harm themselves trying to escape. For these dogs, detach the crate door, place comfortable bedding and a few treats in the back of the crate,

and leave the doorless crate in the run with the dog

Feed him in the crate for a few days to help him acclimate.

Imagine a potential dog owner walking into a shelter and visiting with dogs who can sit, eat without rushing at a food bowl, and calm themselves even when excited to see a new visitor.

Imagine a potential dog owner who sees dogs already partially trained and dogs who won't dash into the street, remain out of control, or leap at guests.

When you spend time training your shelter dogs you are improving them in every way. The mental stimulation from the training prevents the dogs from succumbing to the boredom and stress of shelter life.

The discipline of the training teaches them to respond to limits and remain in control. And the routine of the training helps dogs who arrived with some training retain their skills. This method teaches dogs how to LEARN.

They get relief from the frustration of life in the shelter through their success at learning new skills.

You are also improving the owners. Owners who adopt a partially trained dog can see the rewards of training and are more likely to continue training, especially if they see your shelter as a source of help and guidance

You have now crate trained your shelter dog.

You are offering a new owner a dog who will stay calmly and happily for periods in a crate rather than one that, when unattended, may run loose chewing furniture, dirtying the, house, or jumping up on beds.

prevent accidents, and to reward success.

Adult dogs have better bladder and bowel control, and can "hold it" for a longer period of time than puppies. The rule of

thumb with puppies is to take their age in months, add one, and that's the number of hours the puppy can "hold it" during the day

(i.e. A four-month-old puppy can be expected to be clean for up to five hours during the day).

</p>

<p>Here are some simple steps to help you and your dog find success!

Feed your dog on a schedule (he'll eliminate on a schedule, too).

Keep his diet simple and consistent (avoid table scraps and canned foods; a high quality dry kibble produces the least waste).

Choose an area, about ten square feet, outside, where you wish your dog to potty.

Take your dog on leash to the area, pace back and forth (movement promotes movement) and chant an encouraging phrase

("do your business, do your business").

Do this for no more than three minutes:

if he eliminates, give huge amounts of praise and play.

if he doesn't eliminate, keep him on leash, go back indoors, keep dog on leash with you or confined in a crate.

Try again in an hour; eventually your dog will eliminate appropriately and you can give huge amounts of praise and play.

Note:<i>No punishing of accident! Ignore them but reward the success.</i>

<p>Nuisance barking can be a big problem for owners. No one wants to be the neighbor with the crazy barking dog.

If you want to improve your dog's behavior you first have to understand it

Dogs have different barks for different behaviors. Dogs will bark to alert, for attention or out of frustration and many will bark or howl when left alone.

<p>Barking is very hard for pet parents to work through because a lot of our instincts end up reinforcing the behavior. For example take a dog who is barking

at a strange dog or person on the street. As nurturing human beings, pet parents often think they should soothe and calm him with petting, where the dog most likely will take this to mean you like my behavior, keep doing it. The other major issue is barking dogs can trigger owners to yell or punish the dog to try to stop them.

This might suppress the behavior but it is more likely to cause the dog increased stress and to continue barking. Frustrated owners will sometimes turn to punishment in some form like "anti-bark" shock collars, these tools are not very safe or humane and most of the time they will make the problem worse by creating anxiety.

</p><p>

To train your dog not to bark or to stop barking you will need to understand what is causing him to bark. If a dog is barking because there is something outside triggering him (by sight or sound), change the environment so your dog doesn't have access to watch and bark out the window, or some noise like music to cover sound.

This is a "self-rewarding" behavior for the dog. Think of it from the dogs' point of view. The mailman comes to the house, dog barks, mailman leaves. He thinks he made the intruder go away, success! If your dog is barking or howling because he is alone, increase his exercise routine before you leave him and give him something interesting

while you are gone like a puzzle toy with treats inside. For the attention seeking barker find something that makes him bark out of excitement like a toy, ball or your attention.

Wait until he is quiet and reward him when he stops barking; he will learn quiet behavior gets him what he wants faster than getting too excited.

Lastly, reward and praise your dog when he is calm and quiet. Quiet dogs are often ignored, but barking gets a lot of feedback. Let your dog know he has made the right choice when people walk by the window or when his ears perk up, and he will be more and more likely to watch quietly.

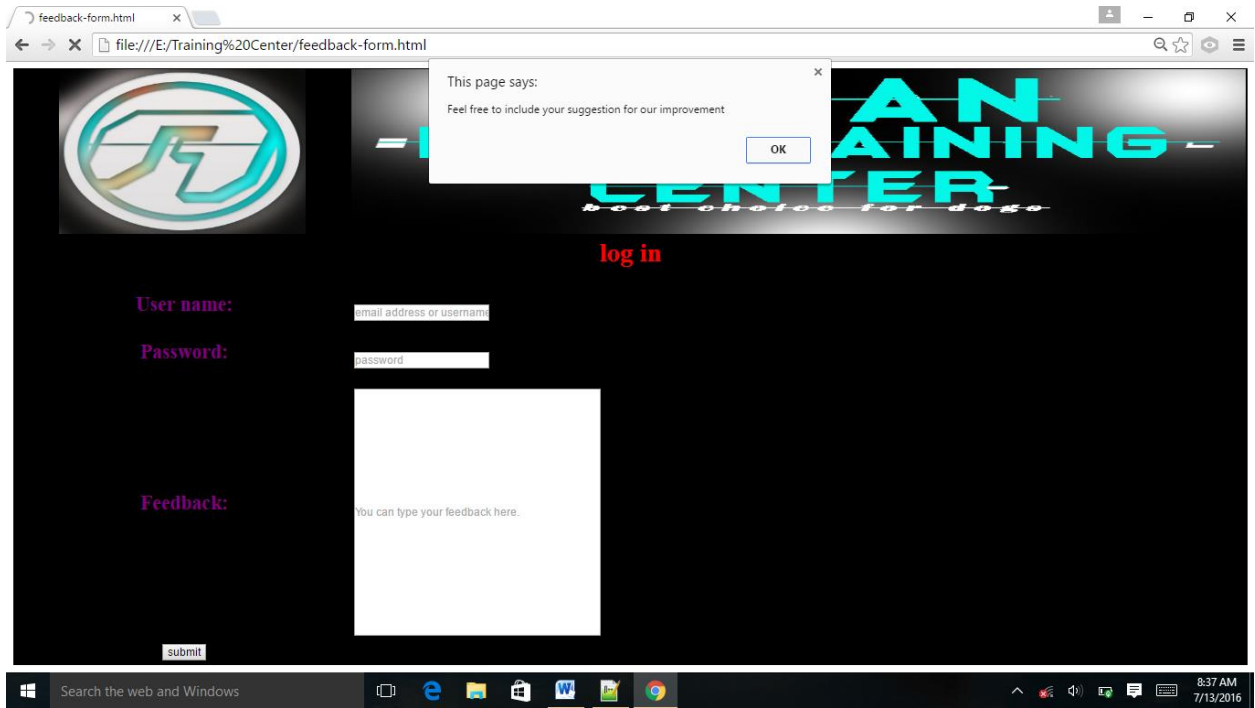


Fig: Test Case No: 1

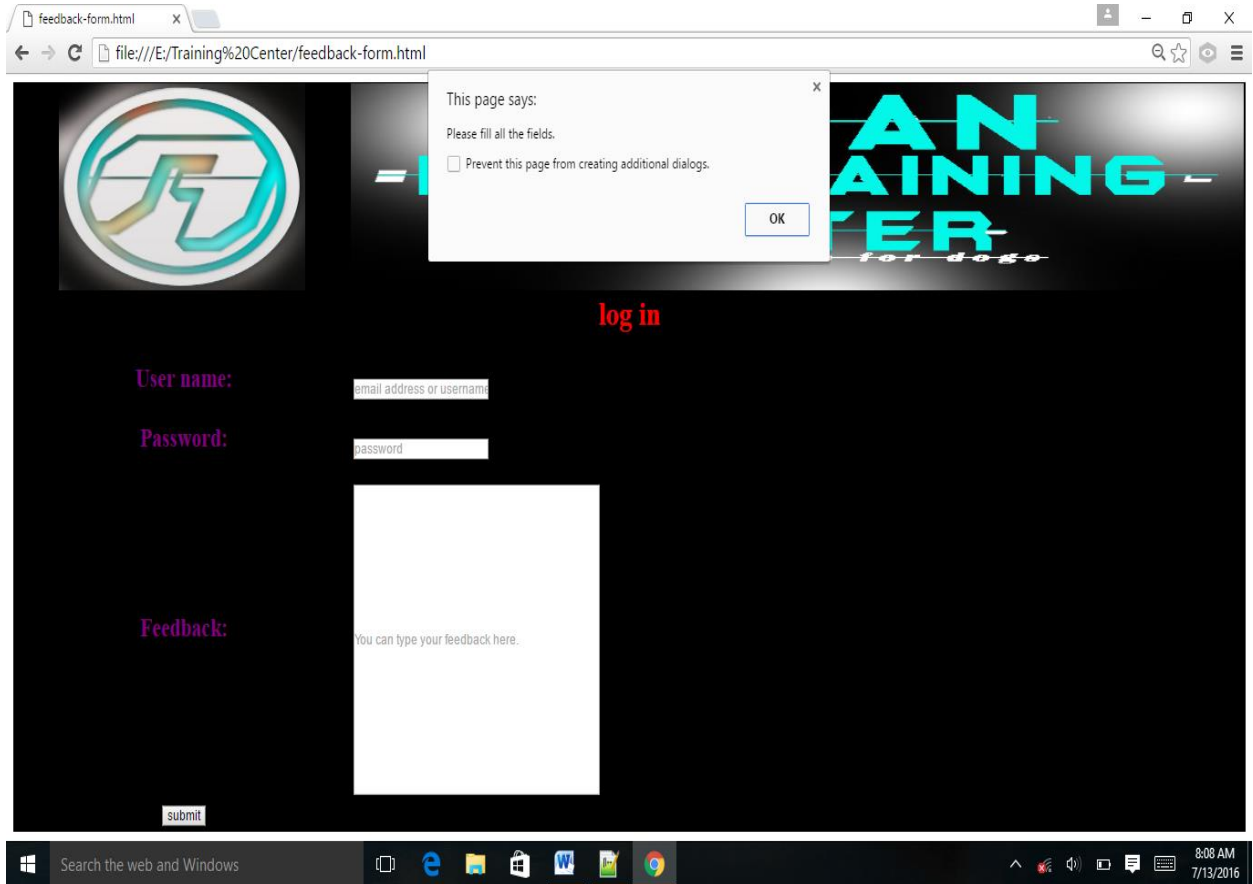


Fig: Test Case No: 2

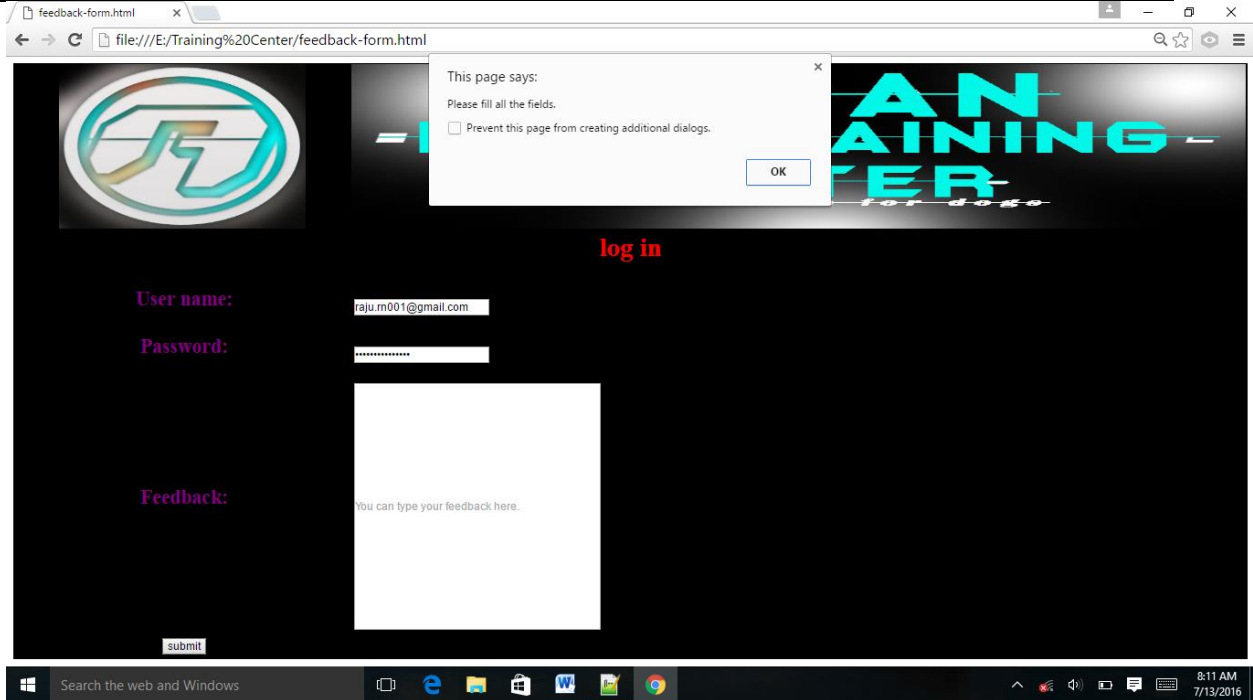


Fig: Test Case No: 3

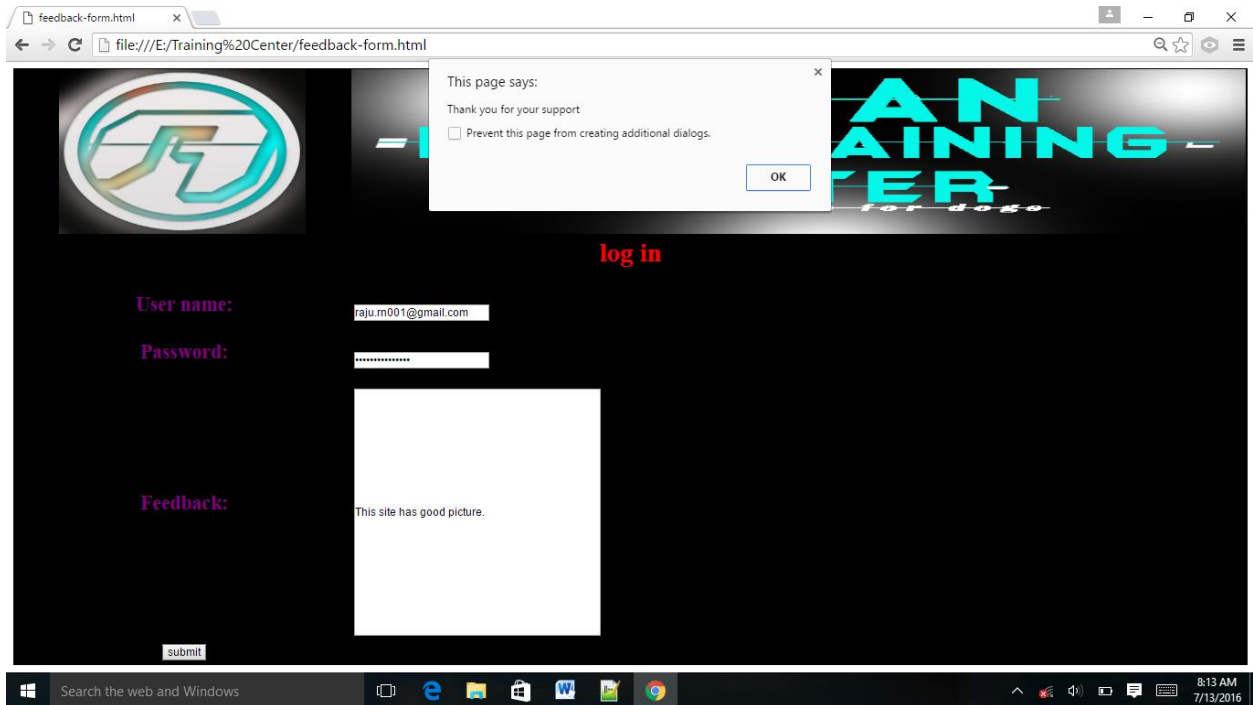


Fig: Test Case No: 4

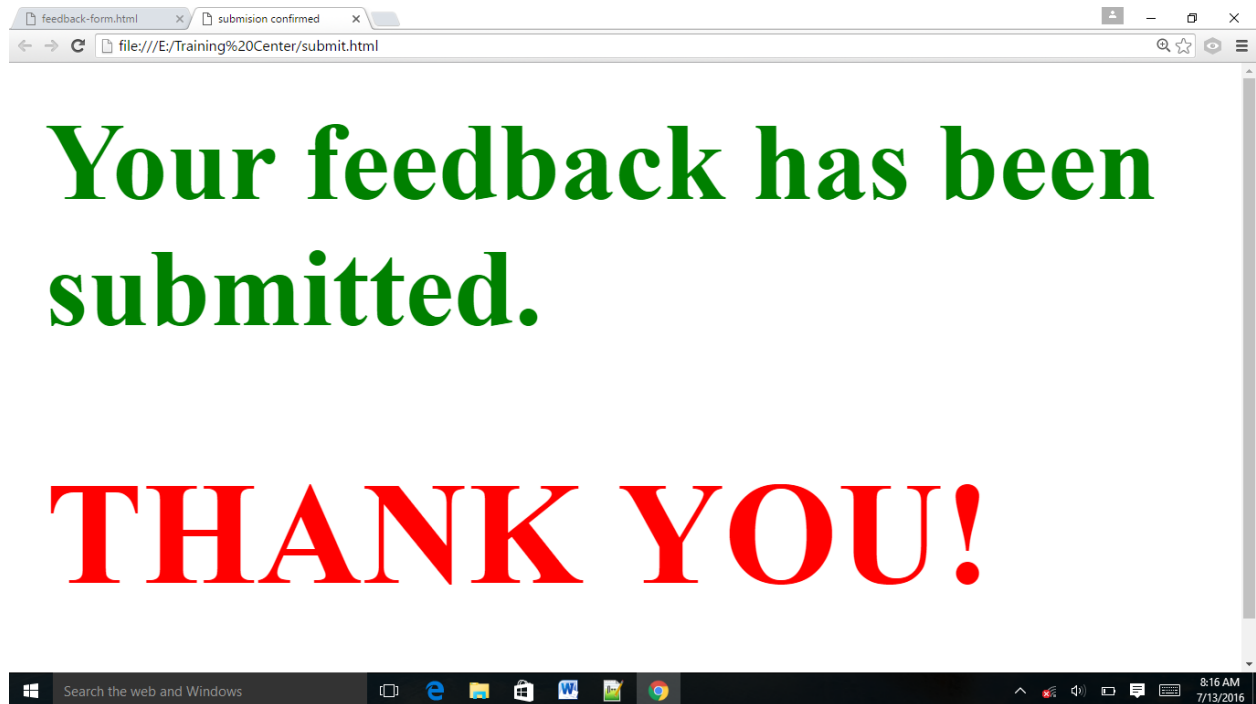


Fig: Test Case No: 5

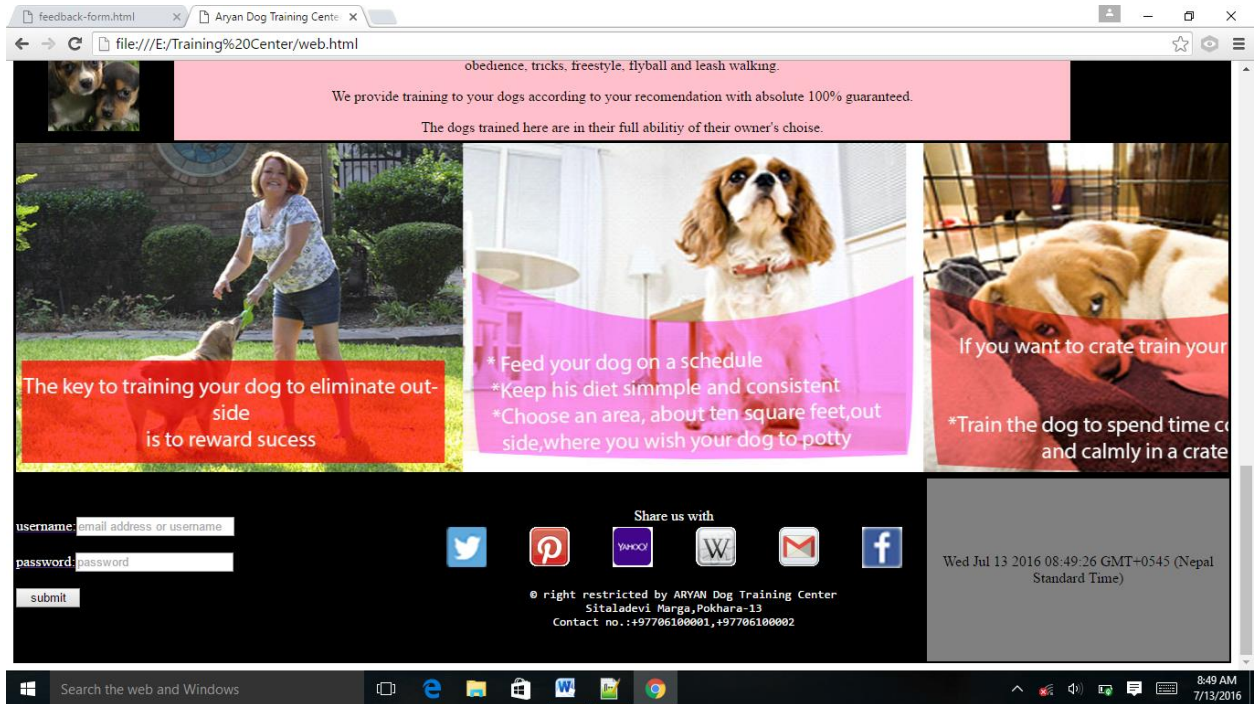


Fig: Test Case No: 7(a)

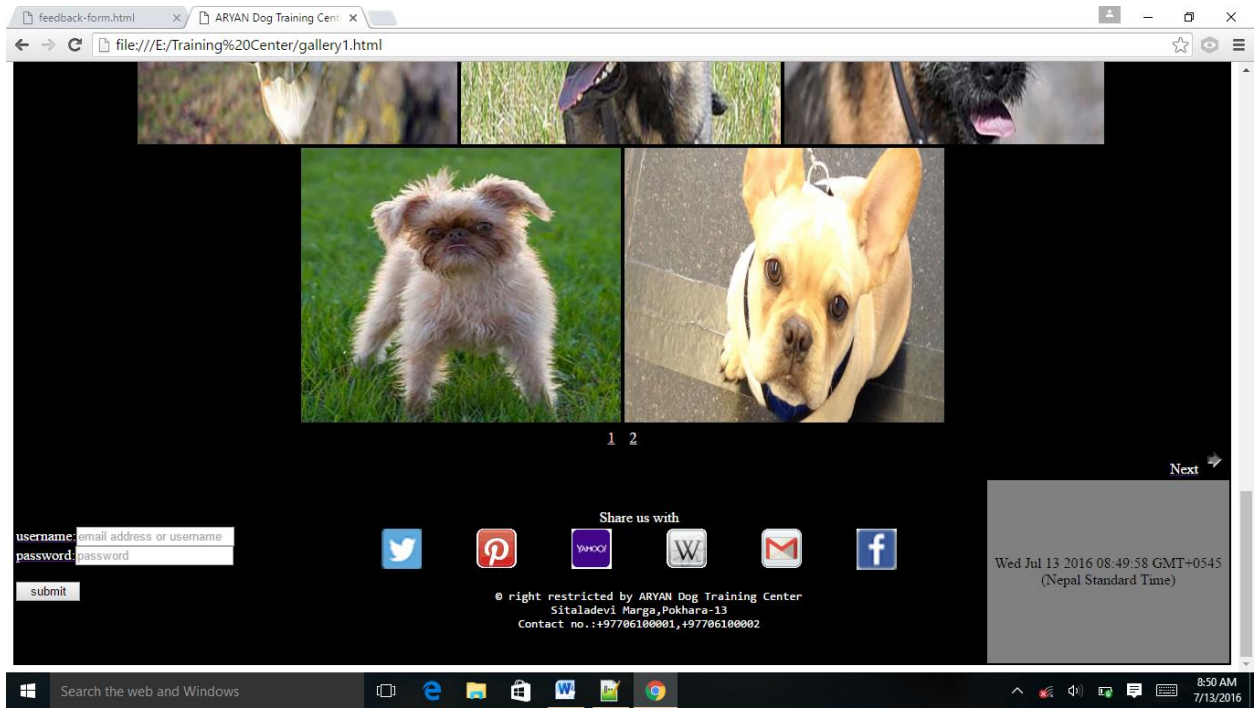


Fig: Test Case No: 6(b)

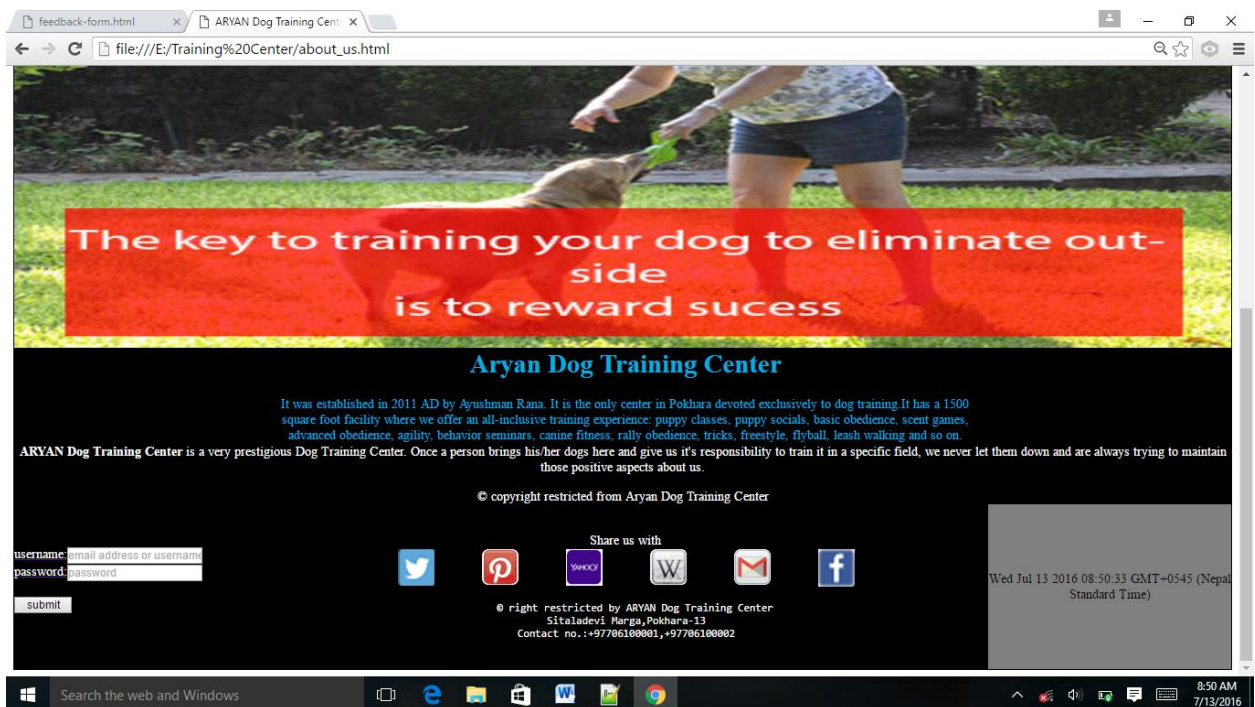


Fig: Test Case No: 6(c)

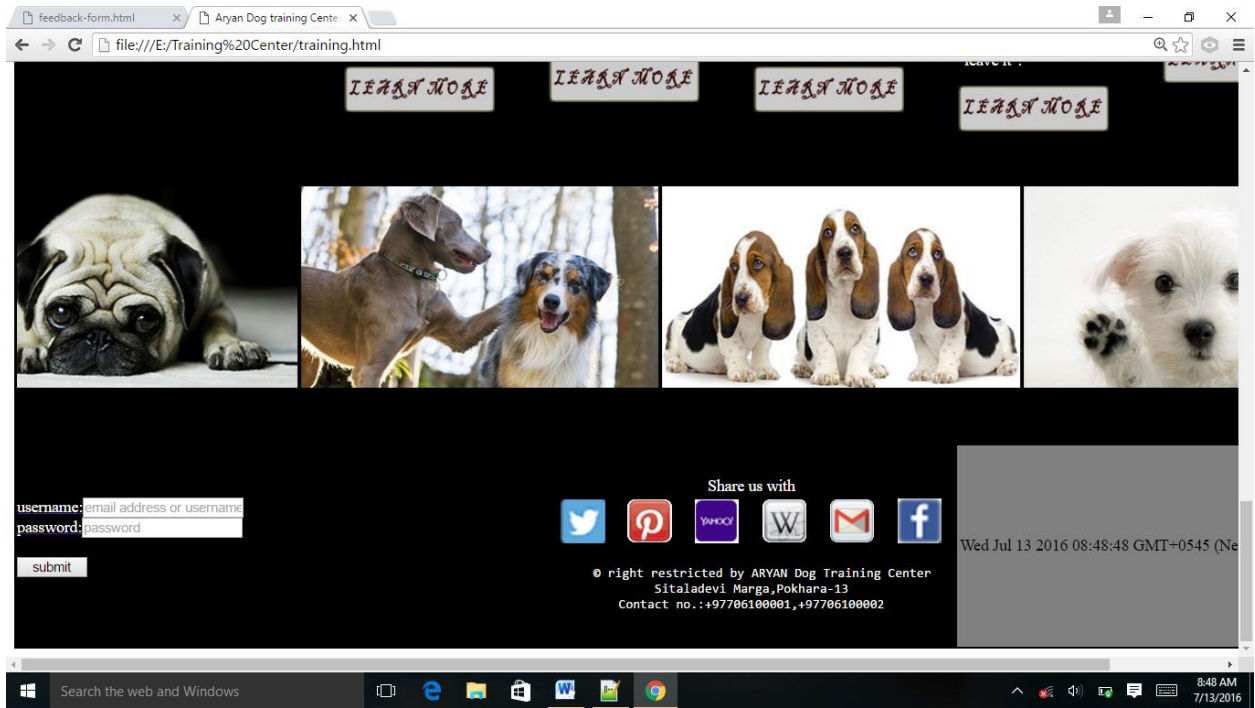


Fig: Test Case No: 6(d)

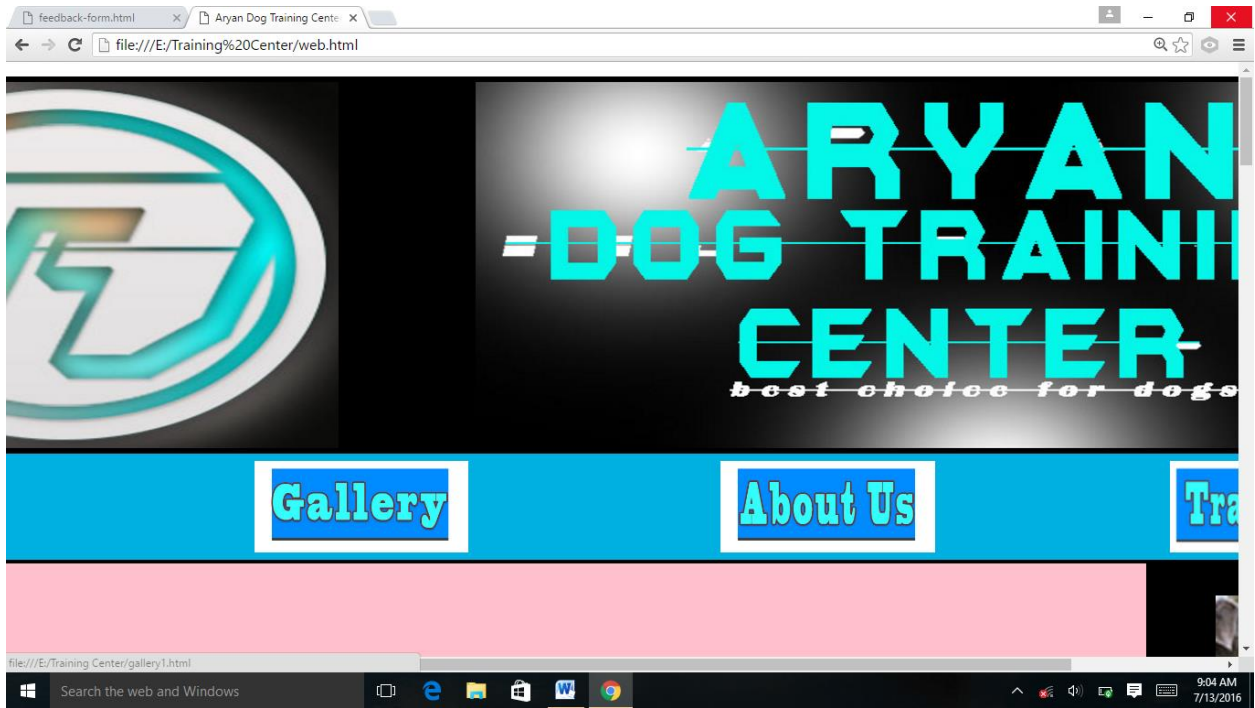


Fig: Test Case No: 7(a)

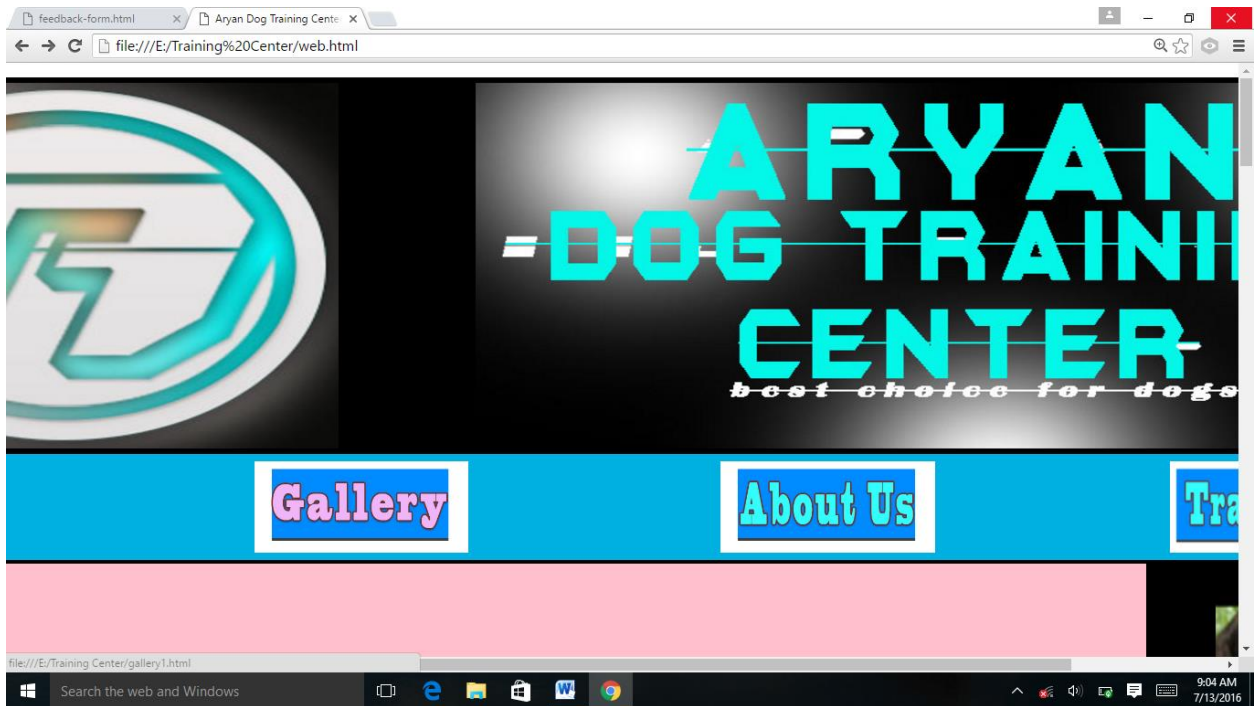


Fig: Test Case No: 7(b) on-mouse-over

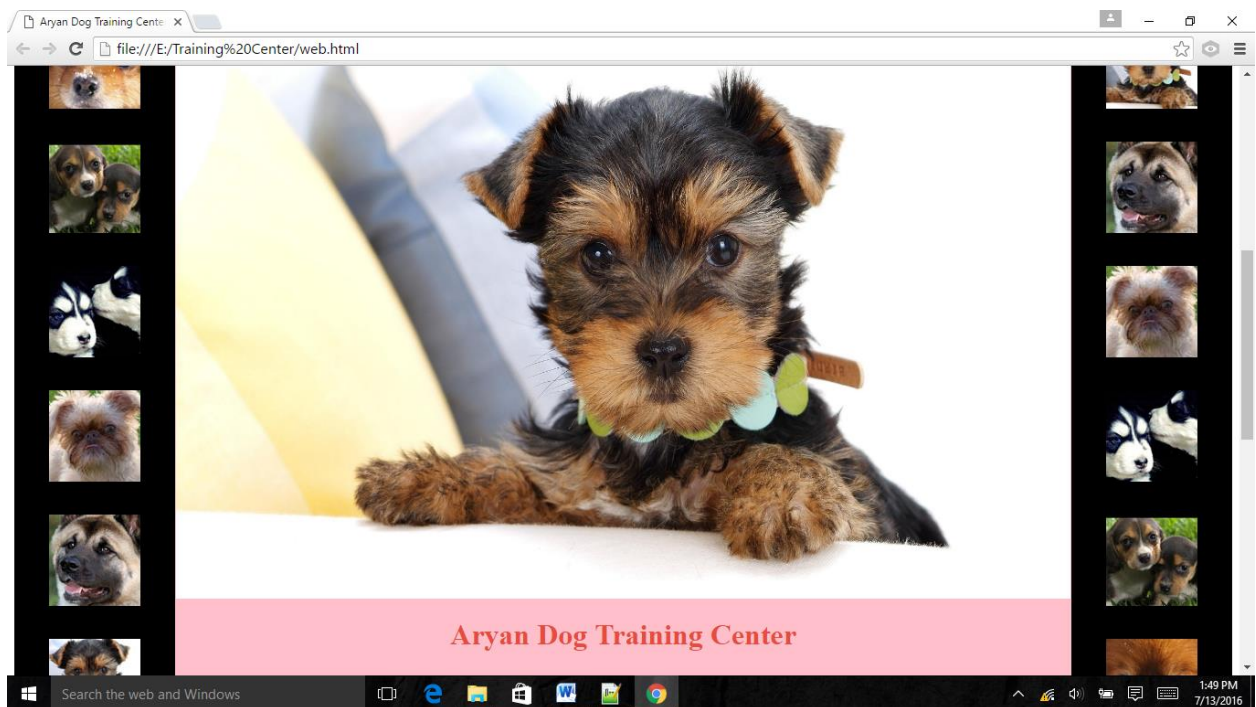


Fig: Test Case No: 8(a)

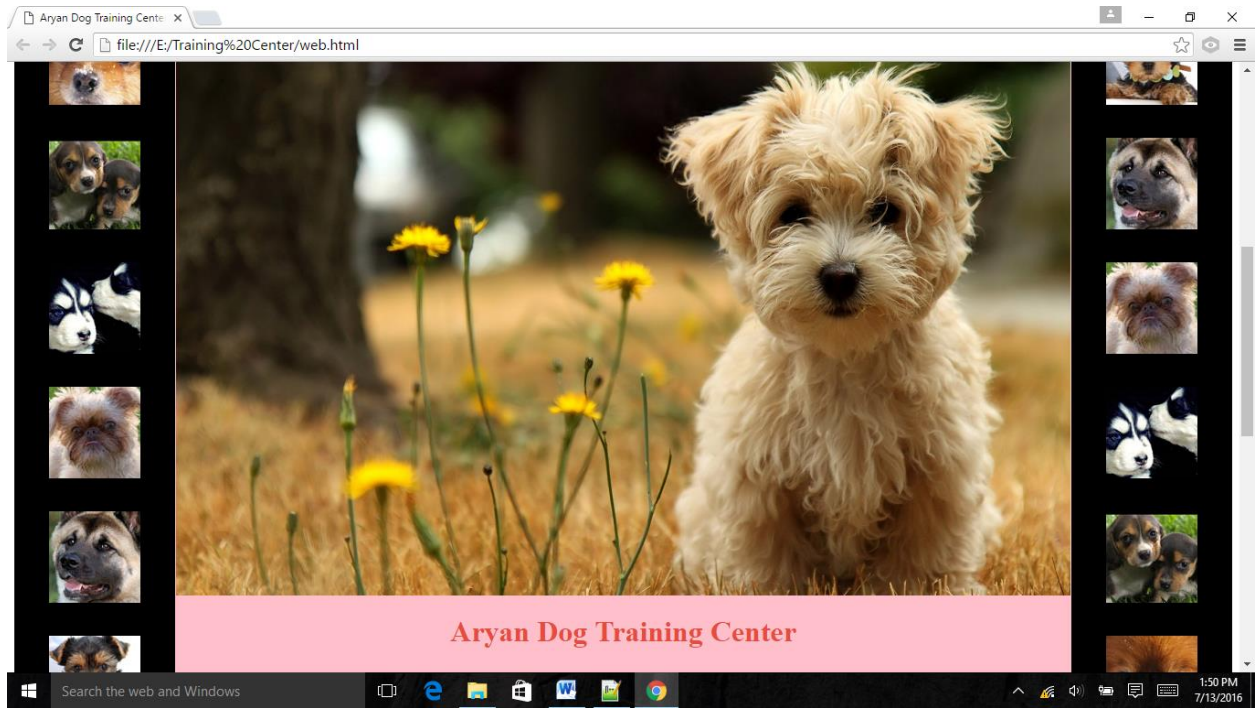
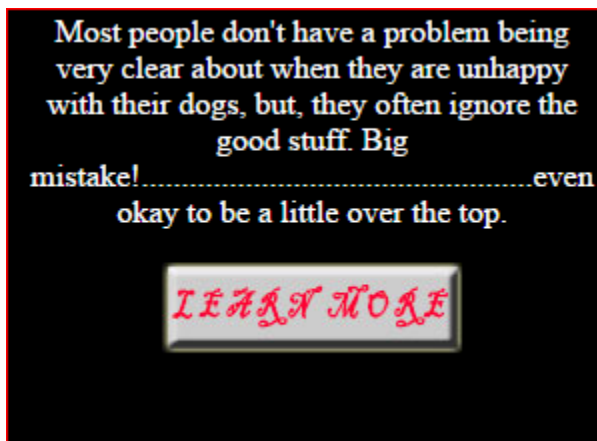
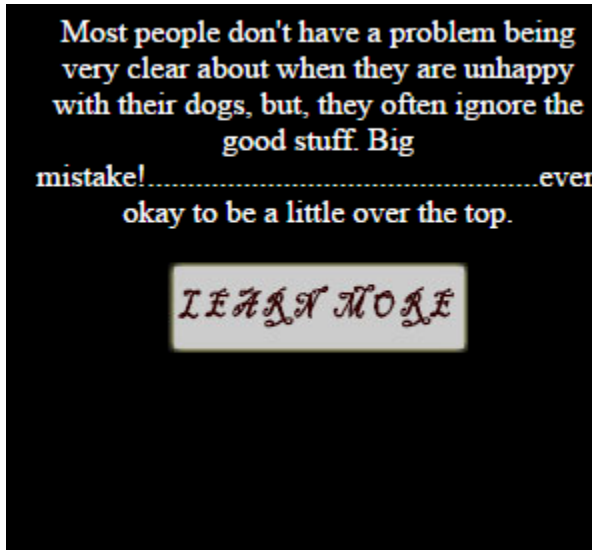

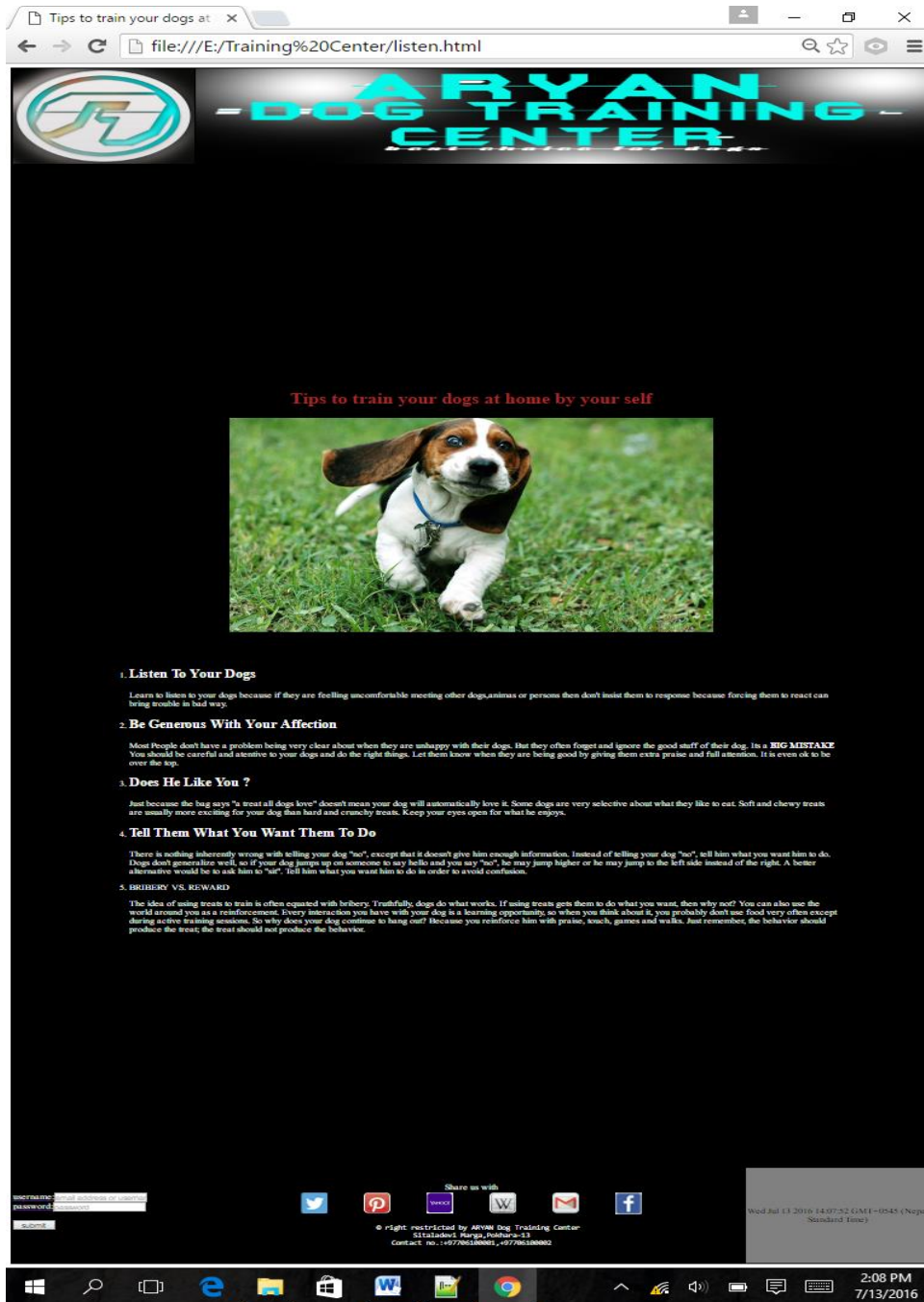

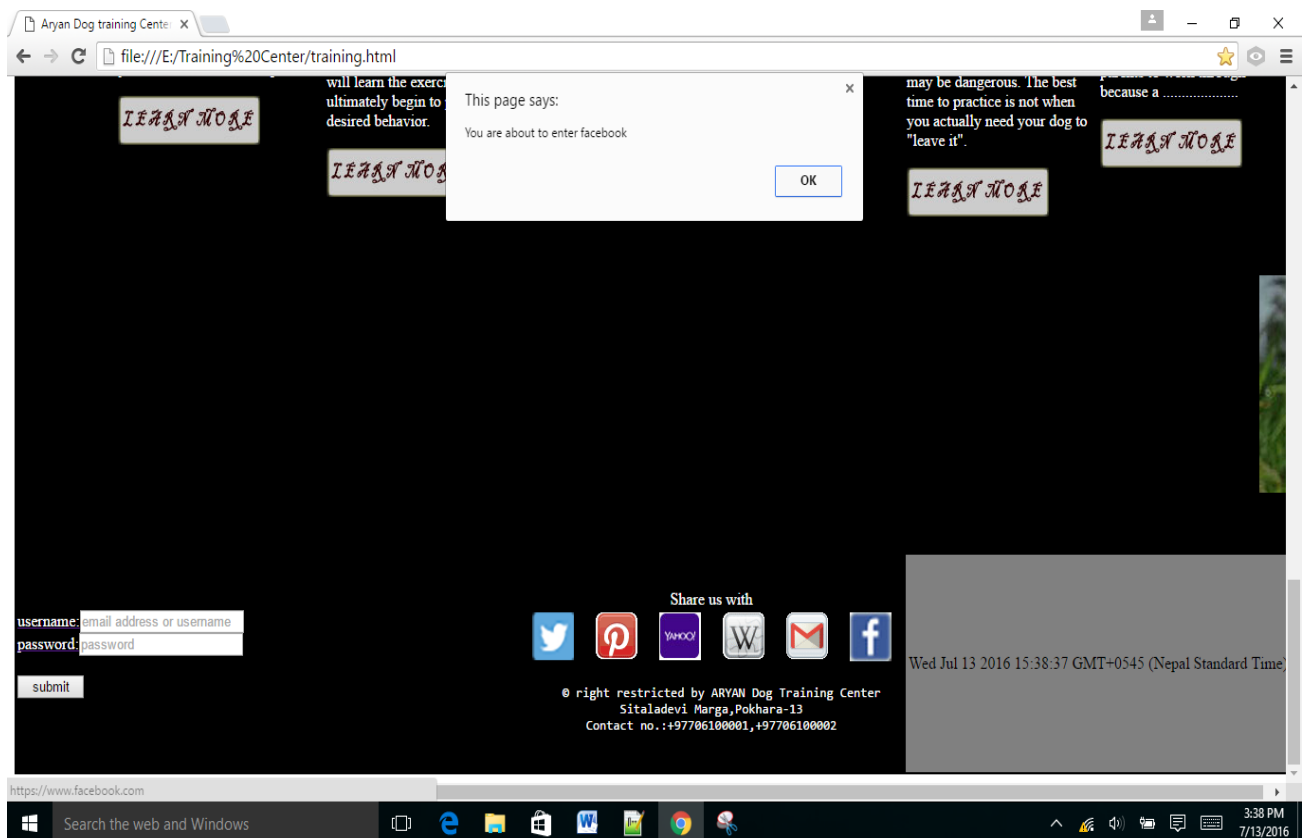


Fig: Test Case No: 11

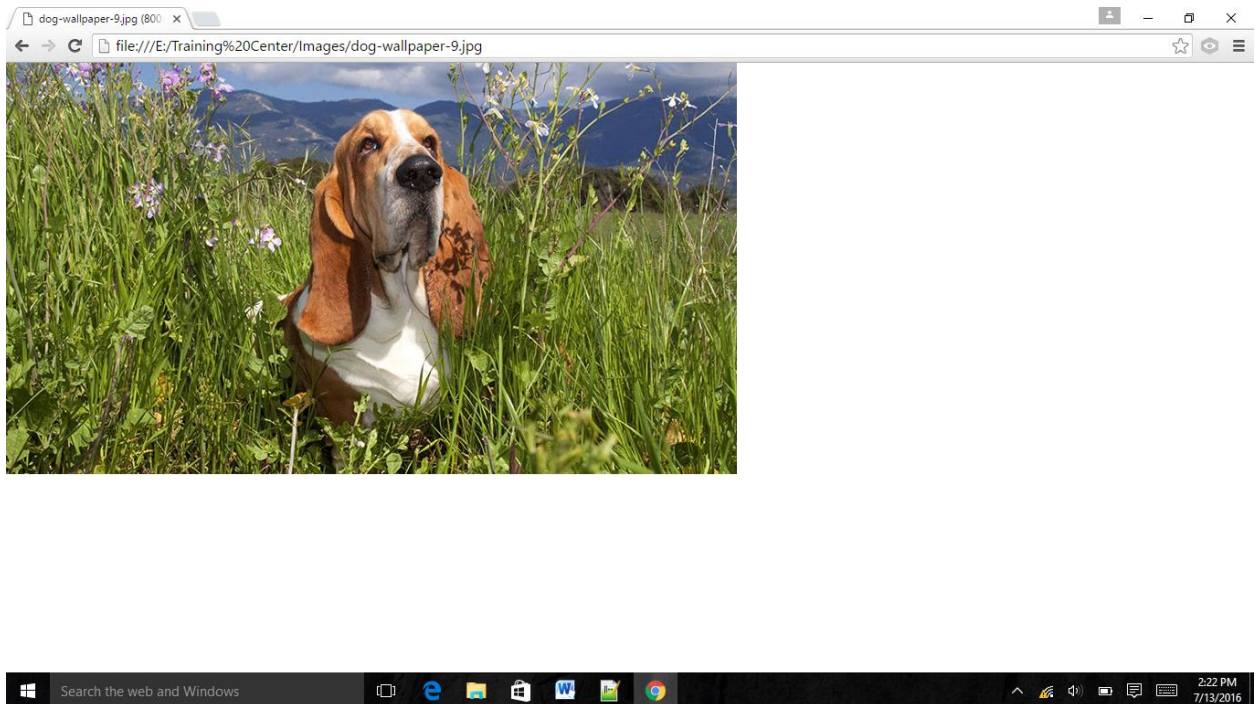


Fig: Test Case No: 12

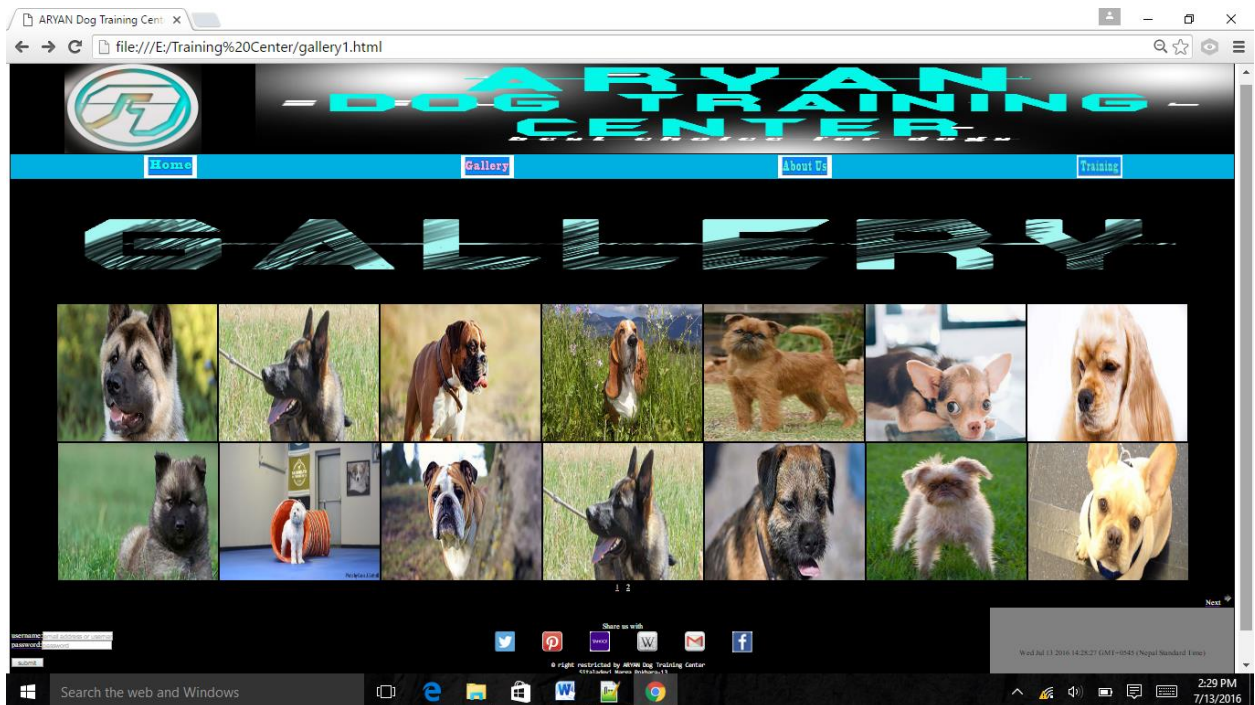


Fig: Test Case No: 13(First page of Gallery page)

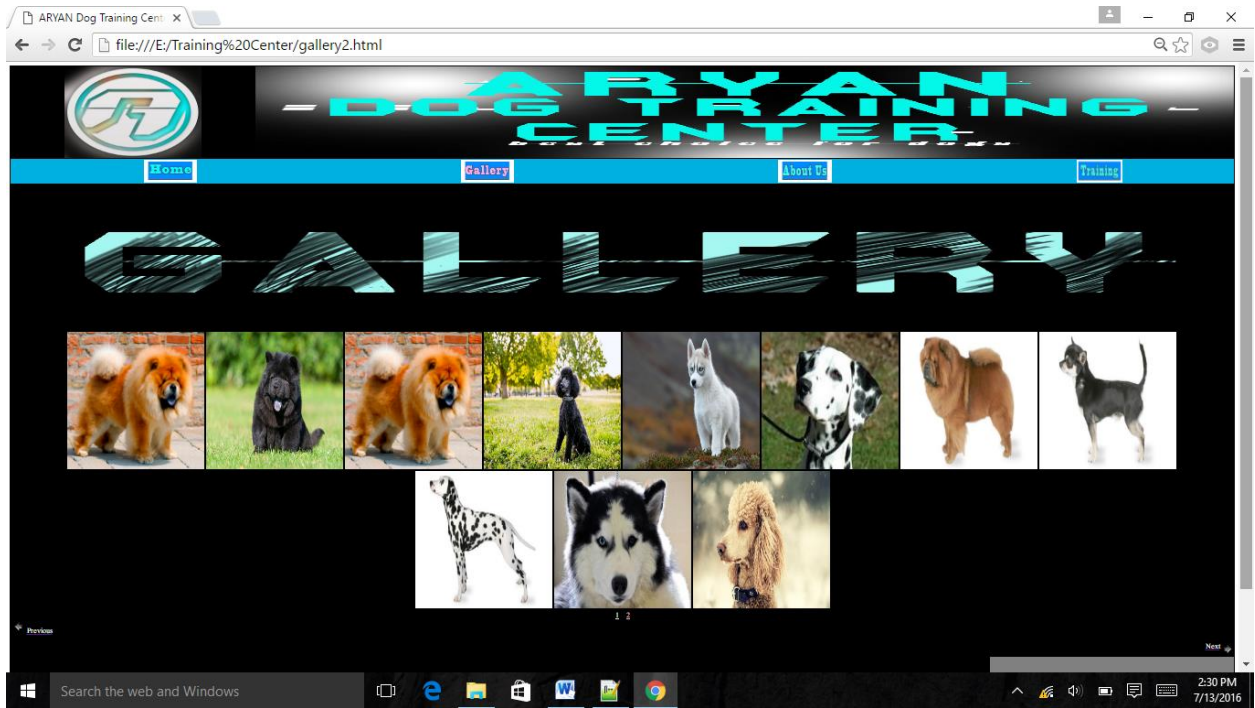


Fig: Test Case No: 13 (Second page of Galley page)

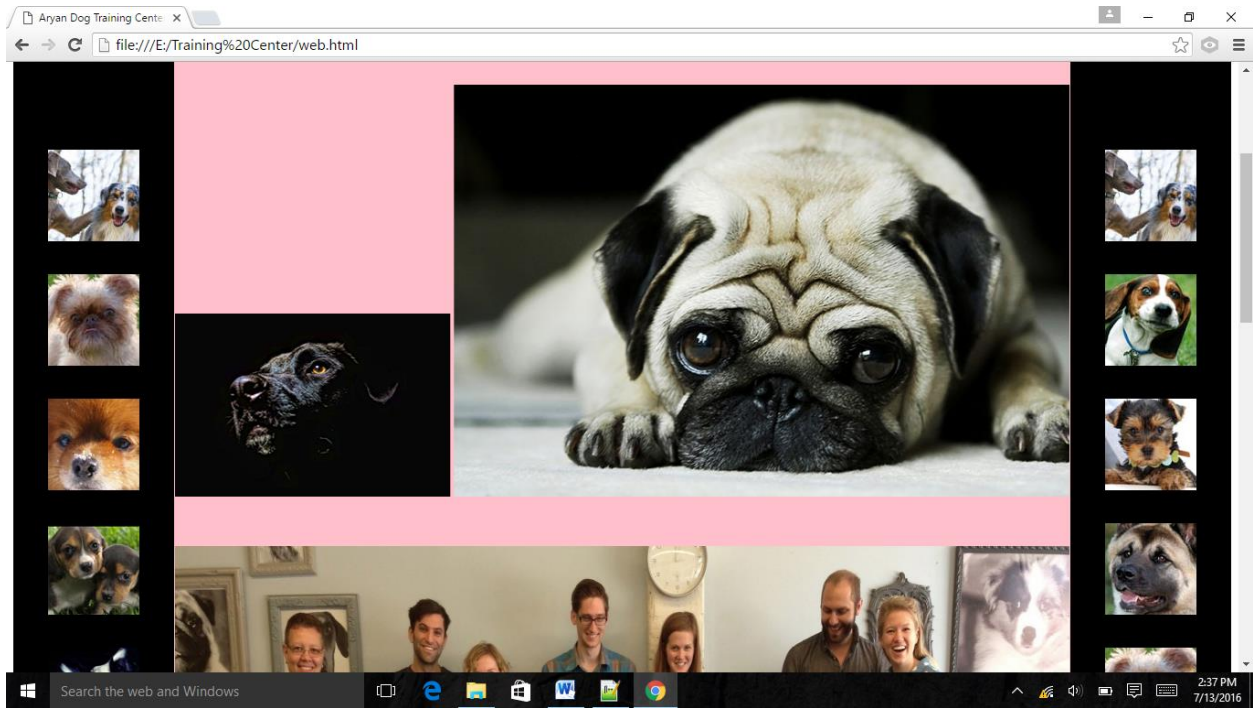


Fig: Test Case No: 14

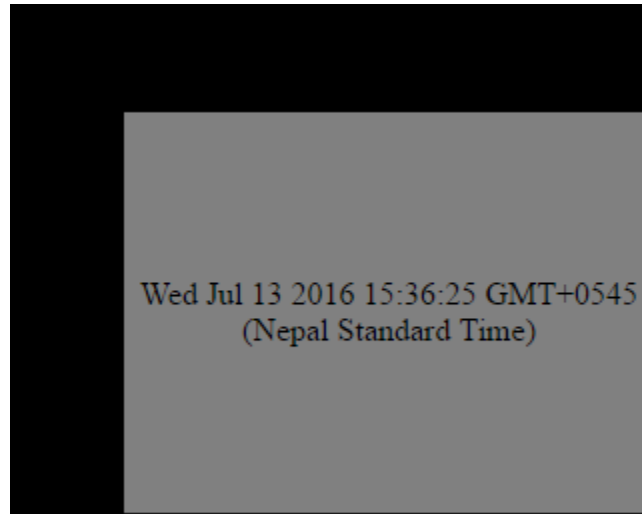


Fig: Test Case No: 15

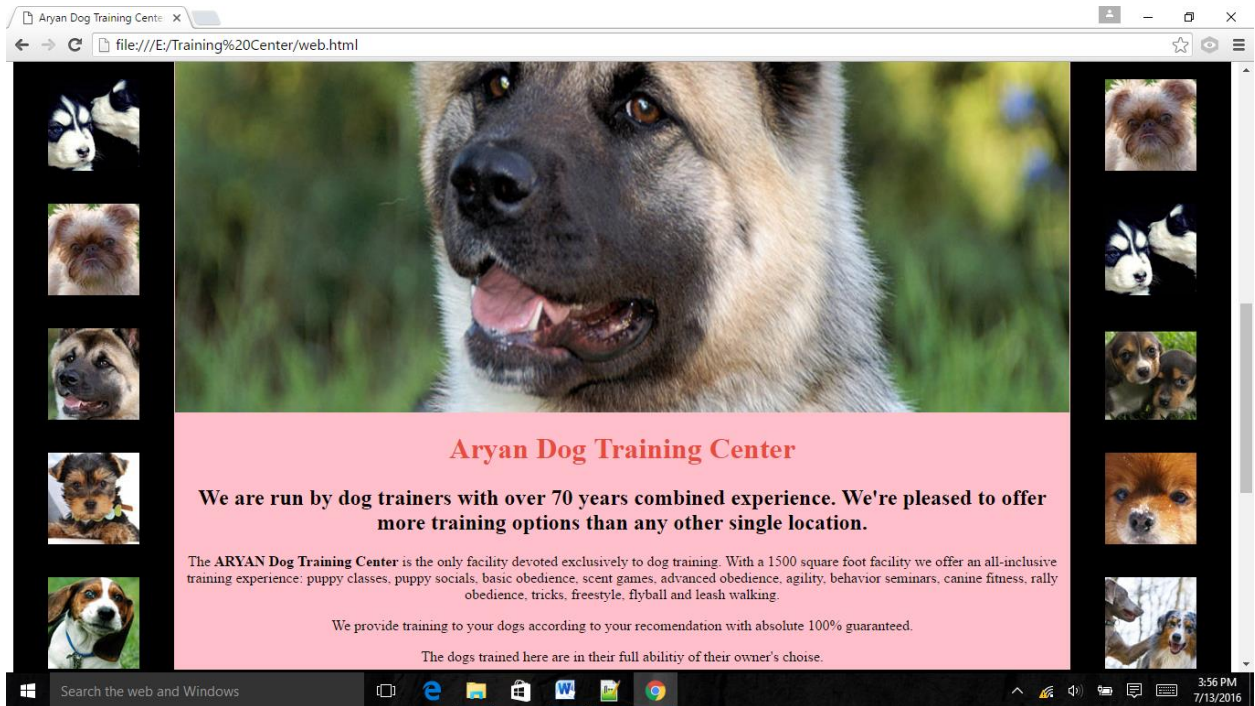


Fig: Test Case No: 16(a)

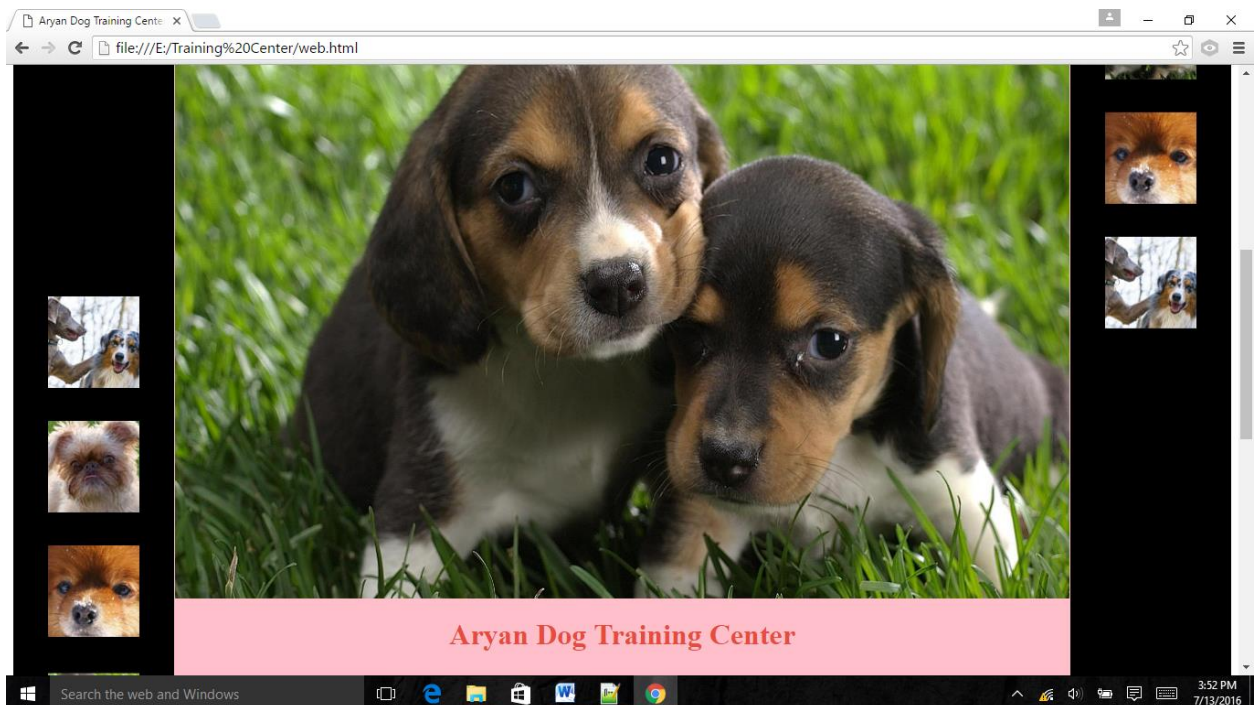


Fig: Test Case No: 16(b)
